SOP for students of Bolpur College

Students of Bolpur College must obey the following directives

A) While entering college campus

- 1) It is mandatory to show identity cards at college gate before entering in the college.
- 2) Entering outsider & non-students in college is strictly prohibited.
- 3) Visitors with specific purpose must record their particulars in the register maintained at the college gate.
- 4) Students must be properly and decently dressed.
- 5) Cycles and bikes of the students must be orderly parked and locked in the parking place behind the main building of the college.

B) Attending classes & other academic activities

- 1) Students must be punctual, regular in attending classes, tutorials, internal assessment/assignments.
- 2) They must sit properly in their respective classrooms and should not attract unnecessary attention of others.
- 3) If a professor is absent or unable to take class, students must sit in their classrooms and maintain silence so that not to disturb the other adjoining classes.
- 4) Students must not use mobile phone or any electronic gadget for their communication during the class.
- 5) Adapting any kind of malpractice such as cheating, copying, and exchange answersheets in examination is strictly prohibited.
- 6) Students must always consult noticeboard (Online and Offline) on a regular basis.
- 7) They must not loiter in the corridors of the College during class hours.
- 8) They must not scribble anything on the walls of black-boards, classrooms, washroom and College campus.

C) Maintaining Environmental Standard

1) Bolpur College is a smoking free campus. This policy not only apply to any materials or devices using tobacco but also applies to any other smoking processes including use of vaping devices, E-cigarettes, electronic nicotine delivery systems and any other similar devices or equipment and substance. These are prohibited in all areas where smoking is prohibited.

- 2) So, smoking, vaping, chewing guthka, consumption paan-masala or of any kind of drug is strictly prohibited and violating this rule attracts severe punishment.
- 3) Keep your Campus clean and green for improving environmental standard
- 4) The students are advised to participate in the activities of nature club to fulfil the objective

D) Library

- 1) Every student must apply for library membership and obtain library card. Only the registered members are allowed to use the library services.
- 2) Talking, using mobile phones in the library reading room is strictly prohibited.
- 3) Books are issued to students for one month. The books must be returned within specified date; or before their Semester form fill up.
- 4) The college library is fully automated and a number of services are available. Students are advised to use Wi-Fi connection inside the library to access online resources and for academic purpose only.

E) Scholarships and office works

- 1) A variety of Scholarships are available. Students are directed to keep informed themselves.
- 2) Girl students are advised to apply for Kanyashree Scholarship
- 3) Avail Education Loan through Student Credit Card facilities.

H) Ragging free & Sexual harassment free campus

- 3) Disciplinary actions include cancellation of admission, suspension, rustication or expulsion from the Institute/ Hostel, filing FIR with the police and even collective punishment may be imposed where the persons involved are not identified.
- 4) Bolpur College campus strives to remain sexual harassment free campus. The college authority undertakes every effort to ensure that no case of sexual harassment takes place within the college campus.
- 5) Sexual harassment includes physical contact or advances, a demand or request for sexual favours, making sexually coloured remarks, showing pornography or asking if anyone wants to see pornography and any other unwelcome physical, verbal or non-verbal conduct of sexual nature.

I) Grievance redressal
